

All-Star Selection Process

- All-star selection/drafts will be treated the same as regular season drafts. No phones or pictures will be allowed. All voting and information discussed is to remain confidential between coaches and HCPRD staff.
- HCPRD will release the names of the All-star roster after all votes have been tallied and final selections have been made by the selected Head Coach.
- Head Coach will be decided by regular season standings. In the event of a tie, the tie will be broken first by head-to-head record, then by runs/points allowed, if needed.
- Non-residents who played the entire season with HCPRD may be considered for the All-Star team provided they meet the GRPA Athletic Manual participation guidelines.
- All coaches from their respective age groups will be involved in selecting up to 12 players for the All-star team (depending on the sport) and the last 2-3 spots will be selected by the Head Coach.
 - HCPRD will email out a link to a form for each age group. Each coach will be required to select up to 4 nominations depending on the number of teams in the age group.
 - Rosters from each team in the age group will be listed on the form under the LAST NAME of the HEAD COACH of that team. **Coaches, please only make selections from your team's roster.**
 - The two last questions at the bottom of the form are required. The first question asks for the nominated player's name, current jersey number, and jersey size. The second question asks for acknowledgment that your nominated players will be available for the days of the All-Stars tournament.
 - Before the all-star selection/draft day, HCPRD will collect nominations submitted and create the ballot for each age group to be voted on at their scheduled selection/draft day.
 - Each ballot will be listed in alphabetical order and will be comprised of names entered from the form link emailed out.

All-star Selection/Draft

1. Coaches enter the draft room and will have 5 minutes each to speak on behalf of each of their nominated players.
2. Coaches will receive their ballots and instructed to move away from each other to complete their votes.
 - a. Coaches will select 8 names for volleyball, 8 names for basketball, and 10 names for baseball/softball on the ballot.
 - b. Once selections have been made, the coach will fold their ballot and return it to a HCPRD staff member.
 - c. Once all ballots have been collected, a HCPRD staff member NOT associated with the Athletics program will tally the votes.
3. Children will be placed on the all-star team based on the number of votes received. The top vote getters will fill the team first until all 8 or 10 slots have been filled (depending on the sport).
 - a. If the initial roster is not apparent for each 8 or 10 spots, a re-vote would be considered using the names of players who received the same number of votes. They will be entered onto a separate ballot and handed back out to all coaches.
